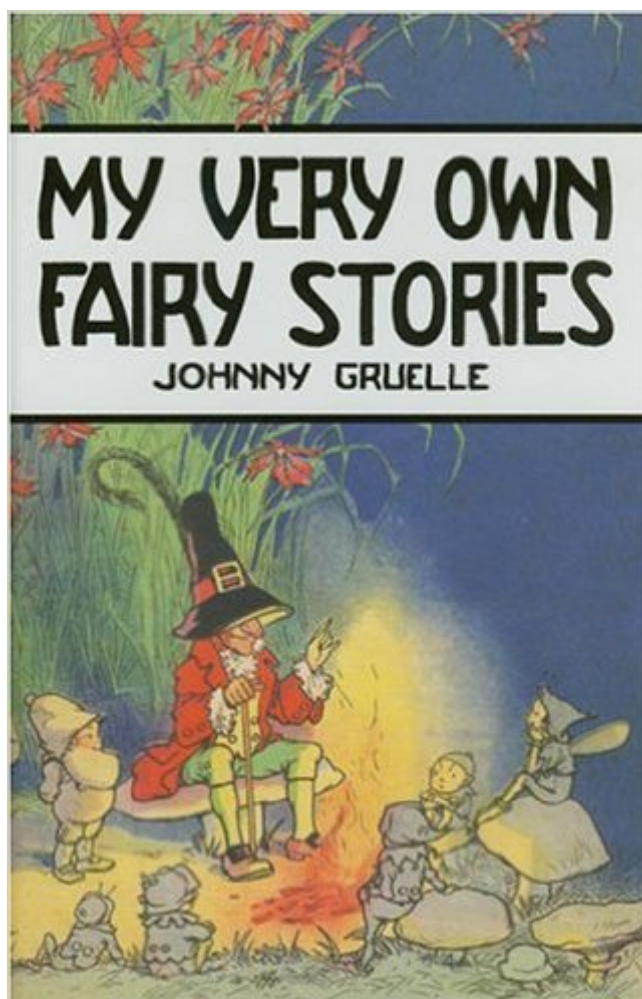


The book was found

Be warned: The version of My Very Own Fairy Stories that has a cover photo of two books and a pen--this seems to be a xerox copy of a 1917 New York Library book. Thus, all the many

illustrations are in black and white and look repro blurry. If you are familiar with Johnny Gruelle's illustrations, you will know that this is a disaster. Much better to buy an old used version with Gruelle's beautiful and original color illustrations. I have no idea why this book was published.

This book, by the author of the Raggedy Ann and Andy series, is a delightful tome of stories appropriate for ages 5 and up. The term "fairy stories" is something of a misnomer, however, as no true fairies appear or even make cameos. Instead, these stories tend to take something from nature (e.g. The Ugly Caterpillar) or something from tradition (e.g. The Discontented King) and spin these people, animals or objects into a nice anecdote to read with your little ones. And the illustrations are gorgeous! Highly recommended if you like vintage kids books and stories.
