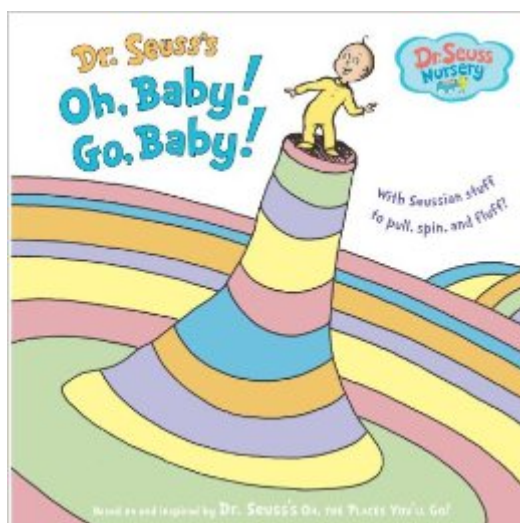

This abridged, "nursery" version of 1990's "Oh, the Places You'll Go!" was intriguing to me, having fallen in love with (and shedding quite a few sentimental tears over!) it while reading it to my oldest grandson on our last day together prior to his starting all-day kindergarten. (There are pluses and minuses to having an opportunity to babysit your grandchildren... 99% pluses, but when they go off into the "big world" of school... oh my, my my - it's that same mixed-feelings, gut-wrenching stuff you experienced when your own children left you!) But with two more grandsons now, I was looking for a cute book to include with the youngest's first birthday gifts - what sold me was the line "with Seussian stuff to pull, spin, and fluff!" The "nursery" category and title of the book distracted me from the age recommendation ("3 and up")... I'd figured it was a book for even younger toddlers.

However, we have several "touch & feel" board books for the 3 & up group, thickly constructed, which have stood up quite well (some better than others) with the grandkids. But this book? Let's just say I wouldn't trust it in the hands of my 3 year/5month year old grandson (whom we affectionately call the "Master of Disaster" due to his aggressiveness with toys/books!) I give it actually "six stars" for the cuteness factor but, realistically, this is not a book to hand to a 3 year old... maybe if you're sitting right there with them and have quick reaction time! It has a couple of pull tabs, a wheel to spin, a shiny balloon and fuzzy-topped mountain to run fingers over, and a page that flips up.
