I liked this volume as it seemed a natural and well thought out progression of the story and characters but it felt like it spent a lot of time going nowhere. The previous volumes have done a great job of picking a story and taking you from start to end at a steady pace but this issue lets you know where it's going and never ever gets there. It steps into side tangents and a story within the story without progressing the main plot. It's much longer than the other volumes and unlike the other physical books it ends without resolution.

It's very adult. Covers the exploration of BDSM by two Lesbian's who meet over their love of Bondage and Discipline. Portrayals as normal people with hopes and fears that enjoy the same fetish. I'd highly recommend it for anyone interested in a loving BDSM relationship.
